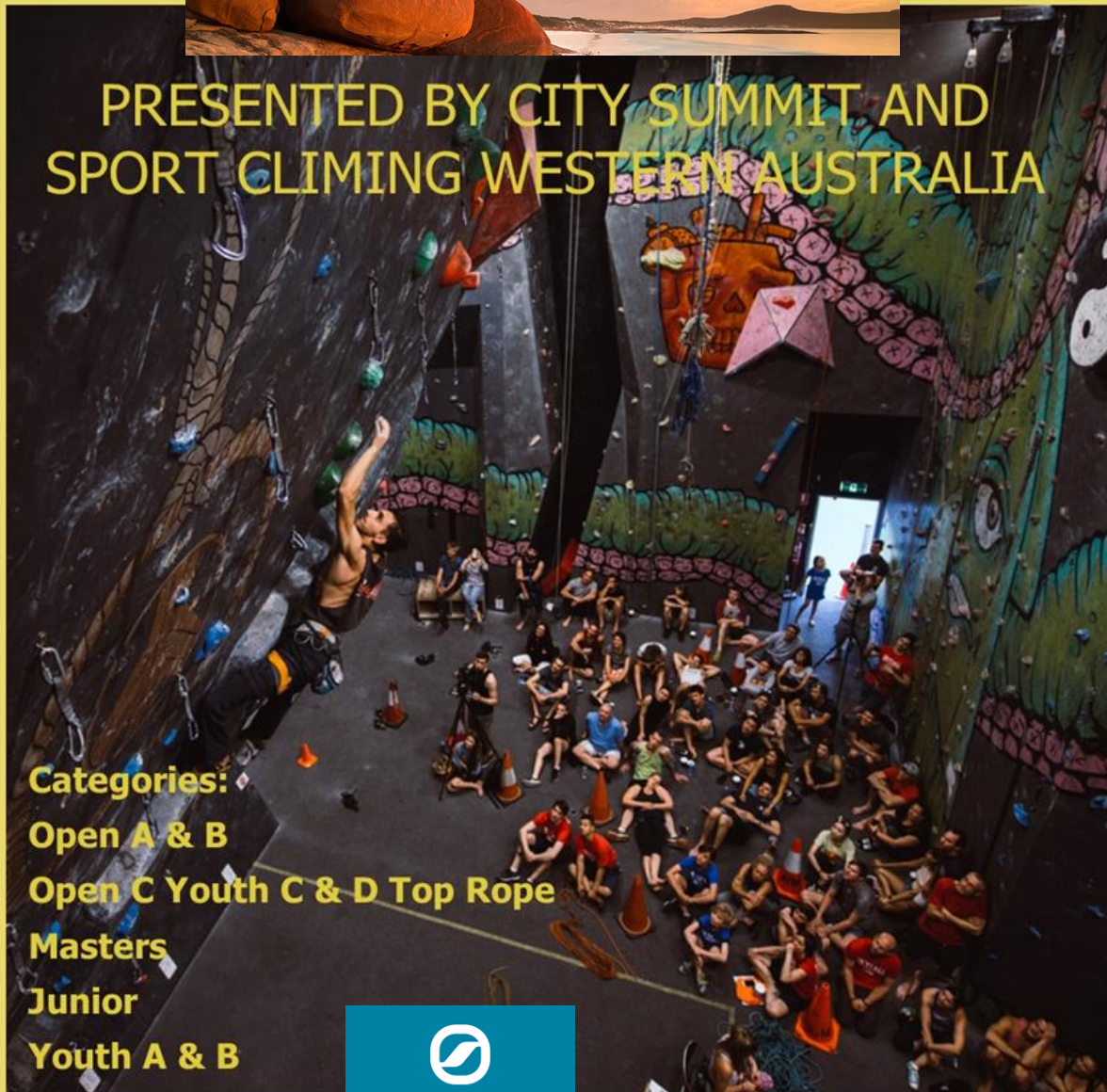

### **1) Date**

WA State Lead Titles will be held on the 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of February 2018

### **2) Location**

### **3) Food, drink and in-between**

Delicious food and drink will be available to keep everyone fuelled up for the whole event. Some of our sponsors and retail partners will also be offering pop up stalls with some great sales and a sneak peak at new products.

### **4) Categories**

There will be male and female categories:

Youth D Born 2007 or after	(Top Rope )
Youth C Born 2005/2006	(Top Rope )
Youth B Born 2003/2004	(can't lead climb go in Open C)
Youth A Born 2001/2002	(can't lead climb go in Open C)
Junior Born 1999/2000	(can't lead climb go in Open C)
Open C – Novice	(Top Rope)
Open B – Intermediates	(Women's > Grade 21 and Men's > Grade 23)
Open A – Opens	
Masters Born 1977 or before	

Masters, Youth A and Junior Lead climbers are welcome to compete in Open A category for this event and will need to register and pay for both categories.

Only Australian team members and continental team members from Youth B can compete in open A and will need to register and pay for both categories.

## **5) Registration**

All competitors must be current State or National members of Sport Climbing Australia. State level membership is \$20 and supports the sport you love. Climbers are required to preregister for the competition, entry fee;

EARLY BIRD \$45 Before 2<sup>nd</sup> of February

LATE REGISTRATION \$65 from 3<sup>rd</sup> of February to 16<sup>th</sup> of February

**Registrations will not be accepted after this date.**

Climbers who are colour blind need to notify SCWA on [info@sportclimbingwa.com.au](mailto:info@sportclimbingwa.com.au) at least one week prior to the event.

## **6) Competition Format**

Climbers in Youth C, Youth D and Open C categories will **top-rope** all routes. Climbers in Masters, Junior, Youth A, Youth B, Open A and Open B categories will **lead** all routes.

The qualifying round will consist of 2 routes in a flash format. Finals will be of an onsight format for the top 8 from each category. Open A and Open B categories will also climb in a semi final round consisting of 1 route in an onsight format for the top 12 competitors from qualifying.

## **7) Rules and Regulations**

- a) An attempt shall be deemed to have started, and measurement of the climbing time shall start, when every part of the competitor's body has left the ground
- b) Competitors will receive 1 attempt per climb only in all rounds
- c) Scoring in Qualifications will be done in accordance to the hold number a climber reaches and/or controls, a "+" being recorded where a hold is reached but not controlled
- d) Scoring for Semi-Final and Final rounds will include the time taken for a competitor to complete their climb. In case of tied points time will be used to separate competitors

- e) An attempt on a route shall be considered successful if the route has been climbed in accordance with the rules and if the rope has been clipped into the karabiner on the final quickdraw of the route (or two hands are placed on the final hold of a top rope climb for 3 seconds) within the fixed time period for attempts.
- f) The attempt of a competitor on a route shall be considered unsuccessful if the competitor:
  - i. Falls.
  - ii. Exceeds the fixed climbing time for the route.
  - iii. Returns to the ground with any part of the body after having started their attempt.
  - iv. Uses any part of the wall, holds or features that are deemed out of bounds or not allowable.
- g) The fixed length of the climbing period in the Qualification round shall be six (6) minutes for each route.
- h) The fixed length of the climbing period in the Finals rounds shall be eight (8) minutes for each route

## **8) Finals Procedure**

- a) The top 8 climbers from the combined score of the qualifier rounds have an on-sight final.
- b) During the final competitors must remain within a designated Isolation Zone until their turn to climb. Unauthorized personnel are not permitted to enter the Isolation Zone.
- c) A collective observation period for all finalists shall be held immediately prior to the commencement of the finals round.
- d) Climbers are escorted by an official to the Competition Area. Whilst in the Competition Area, competitors are not permitted to seek any information from persons outside the Competition Area (e.g. members of the public, coaches etc.).
