## 1) Date

Skyfall is a one day event, held Saturday the 24th of November

## 4) Categories

There will be male and female categories:

Youth D Born 2007 or after (Top Rope)

Youth C Born 2005/2006 (Top rope or Lead you decide on the day)
Youth B Born 2003/2004 (Lead if you can't Lead go in Open C)
Youth A Born 2001/2002 (Lead if you can't Lead go in Open C)
Junior Born 1999/2000 (Lead if you can't Lead go in Open C)

Open C – Novice (Top Rope)

Open B – Intermediates (Women's > Grade 21 and Men's > Grade 23)

Open A – Opens

Masters Born 1978 or before

Australian Youth Team members are expected to register for open A only. City Summit Youth squad and kids club members will be allocated category according to grade and lead proficiency but for registration purposes please register in your age category.





## 5) Registration

All competitors must be current State or national members of Sport Climbing Australia. State level membership is \$20 and supports the sport you love. Climbers are required to preregister for the competition. If you competed in the 2018 State Lead competition or 2018 State Boulder competition you are already a SCA member entry fee;

Early Bird \$45 Before Sunday the 18th of November

Late Registration \$55 Monday the 19<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> of November

Comp fee and the very awesome Skyfall comp T-shirt combo \$60 until the 18th of November

#### Registrations will not be accepted after this date.

Climbers who are colour blind need to notify SCWA on <a href="mailto:info@sportclimbingwa.com.au">info@sportclimbingwa.com.au</a> at least one week prior to the event.

#### 6) Competition Format

Climbers in Youth D and Open C categories will **top-rope** all routes. Climbers in Masters, Junior, Youth A, Youth B, Youth C, Open A and Open B categories will **lead** all routes. City (Summit kids club kids in youth D who Lead can Lead on the in youth C)

The qualifying round is a Pumpfest, will consist of up to 10 routes per category in a flash format deciding the top 3 from each category. Competitors will self-score and provide their own belayers this round however SCWA might have judges assisting on some routes.

Finals will be of an onsight format for the top 8 for Open B and A only.

## 7) Rules and Regulations

- a) An attempt shall be deemed to have started, and measurement of the climbing time shall start (In finals only), when every part of the competitor's body has left the ground
- b) Competitors will receive 1 attempt per climb only
- c) Scoring in Qualifications will be done in accordance to the "Zone" reached on each climb and then tallied up at the end of the round.
- d) An attempt on a route shall be considered successful if the route has been climbed in accordance with the rules and if the rope has been clipped into the karabiner on the final quickdraw for the pumpfest, and within the fixed time period for Finals.





- e) The attempt of a competitor on a route shall be considered unsuccessful if the competitor:
  - i. Falls.
  - ii. Exceeds the fixed climbing time for the route in Finals.
  - iii. Returns to the ground with any part of the body after having started their attempt.
  - iv. Uses any part of the wall, holds or features that are deemed out of bounds or not allowable.
- f) The fixed length of the climbing period in the Finals rounds shall be eight (8) minutes for each route

#### 8) Finals Procedure

- a) In Open A and Open B the top 8 climbers from the combined score of the qualifier rounds have an on-sight final.
- b) During the final competitors must remain within a designated Isolation Zone until their turn to climb. Unauthorized personnel are not permitted to enter the Isolation Zone.
- c) A collective observation period for all finalists shall be held immediately prior to the commencement of the finals round.
- d) Climbers are escorted by an official to the Competition Area. Whilst in the Competition Area, competitors are not permitted to seek any information from persons outside the Competition Area (e.g. members of the public, coaches etc.).





# 10) Volunteers

The Pumpfest qualifier will be self-scoring however we will need judges for Open B, Open A finals. SCWA will also take the opportunity to train Lead Judges at this event for next year's State lead titles. A volunteer link will be posted.

### 11) Provisional Schedule

#### Saturday 24th of November – Qualifying Rounds
