Nourishment

Delicious food and drinks will be available through-out the day and will be supplied by the Summit Cafe. There will also be a Cake Stall raising funds for the City Summit Kids/Development/Youth Teams.

Registration

All competitors must be current State or National members of Sport Climbing Australia.

State level membership is \$20

Any competitor who participated in the 2020 Lead state Titles or 2020 Boulder state titles are already members and would only need to register and pay for Skyfall. Climbers are required to preregister for the competition.

Entry fee

Early Bird \$45 (until 30th October)

Early Bird/ Skyfall comp Tee \$65 (until 30th October)

Standard Entry \$60 (closes midnight 10th November)

Registrations will not be accepted after midnight 10th of November.

Competition format

*Beginner Top rope

Intermediate Lead

Advanced Lead

The qualifying round is a Pump-Fest format and will consist of up to 7 routes per category climbed in a flash format. Competitors will be required to self-score during this round. Competitors will need to **provide their own belayer and Equipment** for the pumpfest round. See Belayer Policy below.

The top 6 competitors in the Intermediate and Advanced categories will have a finals round, which will be held in On-sight format. Belayers/judges will be provided for finals.

*Please note, the Beginner category is for those who are new to the sport, or climbing at or below approximately grade 18. It is expected that participants who have been climbing for an extended time or regularly in other disciplines (e.g. bouldering) will enter the intermediate category. Additional lead courses will be held prior to the event to enable individuals wishing to compete in the Intermediate category who do not yet know how to lead. We will also be running special deals on equipment in our Proshop in the run up to the event.

Belayer & Equipment Policy

Climber's are required to provide their own belayers for the pumpfest round. This can be another competitor (same category) or anyone who holds a lead pass at City Summit.

All competitors and belayers must hold a lead pass for City Summit to be able to climb or belay during the event.

Those who wish to enter who do not hold a pass must receive a lead climbing and belaying assessment from a staff member prior to the event date.

Belay assessments will not be available on the day of competition. The gym closures will occur up to 3 days prior to the event so schedule accordingly.

Belayers for the finals round will be supplied by the event team.

No ropes, harness or belay equipment will be lent out by City Summit or Staff on the day and so climbers/belayers are expected to supply their own equipment (ropes, suitable belay device & carabiner, etc.)

*Failure to attain a valid City Summit lead pass will result in competitors being unable to compete. No Refunds will be given in this situation.

*Please note Covid Guidelines and restrictions will be addressed and adhered to accordingly. Staff and event management asks for your support and understanding with any policies put in place to ensure the safety of everyone attending.
